My dear Sir

In reply to yours of March 13th
I enclose a list of shocks for Jan 18 + 19th
one of which was seven. The time
given is Japan Time or 9 hours before
Greenwich or 135° E. Long. It refers
to the first tremors recorded by a seismograph
at Seisinsyo. The origin of the
seven shock may have been 60 miles

North of Tokio
On Feb 27th my house & Observatory were destroyed
by fire & I lost all that I had collected
during the last 20 years. I wish however
to try and get you information about the
shocks in May. I leave Japan at
the end of June, so address me to Geological
Society, Burlington House London
